


How to access packages

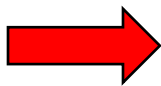
